Author Tom Robbins, recipient of the the Library of Virginia's Lifetime Achievement Award in 2012, spent several years in the mid- to late-1940s growing up right here in Warsaw. His nine novels have sold millions, and *Writer's Digest* named him one of the best writers of the 20th century. His works include *Another Roadside Attraction* (1971), *Even Cowgirls get the Blues* (1976), *Still Life with Woodpecker* (1980), *Jitterbug Perfume* (1984), *Skinny Legs and All* (1990), *Half Asleep in Frog Pajamas* (1994), *Fierce Invalids Home from Hot Climates* (2000), *Villa Incognito* (2003), *Wild Ducks Flying Backward* (2005) and *B Is for Beer* (2009).

Mr. Robbins will autograph copies of *Tibetan Peach Pie*, which we will have for sale, after his talk.
